coupled receptors that stimulate cAMP production in response to serotonin (5-

hydroxytryptamine). The gene product is a glycosylated transmembrane protein that

functions in both the peripheral and central nervous system to modulate the release

of various neurotransmitters. Multiple transcript variants encoding proteins with

distinct C-terminal sequences have been described. [provided by RefSeq, May 2010]

**Protein Description**: Human 5HT4R full length protein-synthetic nanodisc

Formulation: Lyophilized from nanodisc solubilization buffer (20 mM Tris-HCl, 150 mM NaCl, pH

8.0). Normally 5% – 8% trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization. Please
