Background: CCL3 is a cytokine belonging to the CC chemokine family. Chemokines are a family

of structurally related leukocyte chemoattractant cytokines that play a central role

during immunoregulatory and inflammation processes. All chemokines contain four

conserved cysteines linked by disulfide bonds, and two major subfamilies, namely

CXC and CC, are defined on the basis of the first two cysteines which are separated

by one amino acid or are adjacent. CCL3 is involved in the acute inflammatory state

in the recruitment and activation of polymorphonuclear leukocytes.

Endotoxin: < 1.0 EU/mg of the protein as determined by the LAL method

Formulation: Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in PBS with 5% Trehalose and 5% Mannitol.

Storage: Generally, lyophilized proteins are stable for up to 12 months when stored at -20 to

-80°C. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-8°C for 2-7 days. Aliquots of

reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.
